Evaluation & Moderation Redesign

2 Core Objectives:

- Provide a new dedicated hub and journey for evaluators that is easier to navigate, intuitive and focussed on the process of evaluation and moderation. Introducing greater flexibility for evaluators to chose how they work, improved progress tracking and save warnings and a refreshed user interface.
- Provide a new dedicate space for procurement leads to manage and monitor the Evaluation & Moderation process

Document Purpose

This document has been created to provide a high-level overview of our upcoming Evaluation & Moderation Redesign.

It is not intended to act as a user guide or full specification for the upcoming development.

All designs shared are subject to change as the development works progress.

Prior to the delivery of the new E&M Hub, currently scheduled for our Autumn Release we will provide further information and user guides.


Hub Home & Evaluation Journey

Evaluators will start their journey at the new Hub Home Page, directed here from either the evaluation link or from the Atamis Home Page.

The Hub will default to “To Action” but have various views:

- **To Action** – projects for which evaluation has been started, and the user has been assigned as an evaluator.
- **Upcoming** – an optional view to show projects with upcoming evaluations that are yet to be started however with the user assigned as an evaluator to support future resource planning
- **Closed** – previous projects for which the user was an evaluator
- **All Projects** – a combined list of all of the above 3 views and the view for which the search function would default to.

For initial launch, the side panel will be defaulted to supporting documentation, however designs have been created to support wider functionality such as messages or tasks in future releases.

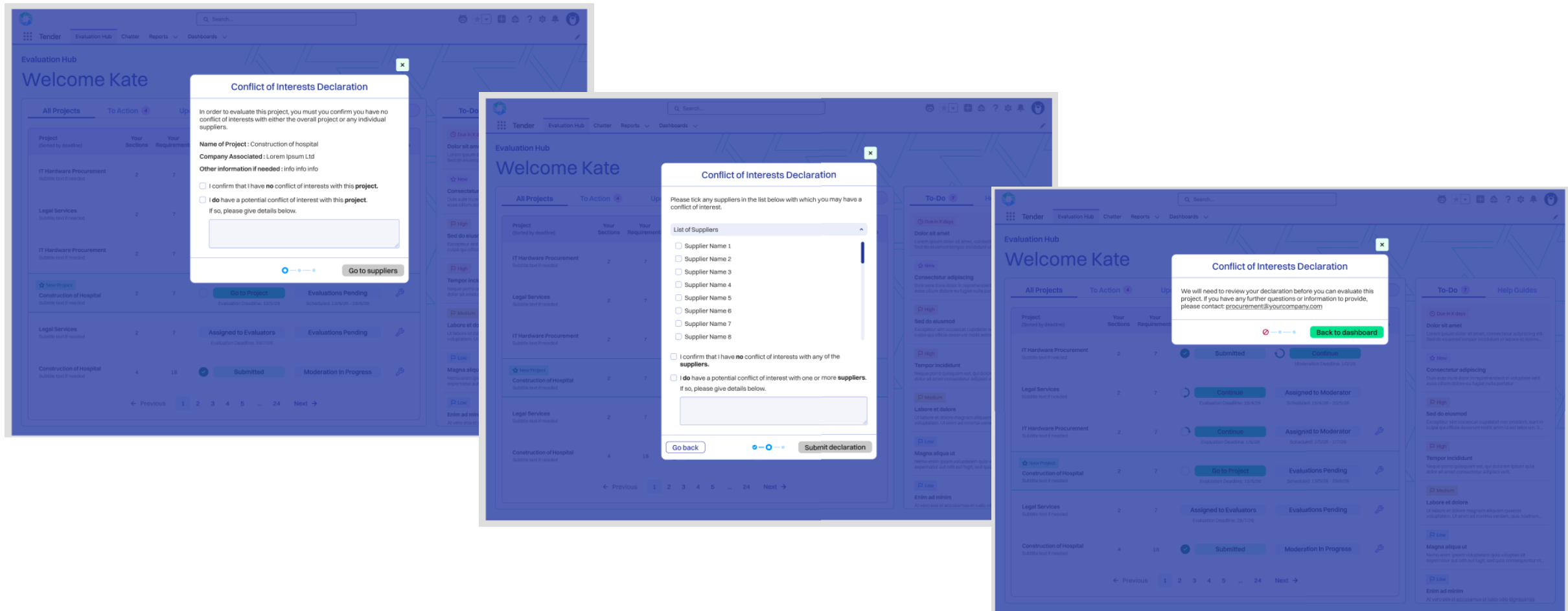
- Multiple views to support users find current, future and past project evaluations:** Points to the view tabs (All Projects, To Action, Upcoming, Closed) and the search bar above them.

- Links to Project for Procurement Leads (permissions based):** Points to the 'Go to Project' button in the 'Construction of Hospital' row.
- Side panel to provide guides for initial launch with expended functionality in future updates:** Points to the 'To-Do' and 'Help Guides' sidebar on the right.

Improved COI Declaration Process

The first time an Evaluator clicks through to start an evaluation, they will be asked to declare any conflicts of interests.

The improved conflicts of interest functionality will also now enable users to declare project and specific supplier conflicts with larger, expanding comments fields.

Alongside the new declaration process, buyers will also have improved functionality to manage and act on declared conflicts which is covered later in this document.



Evaluators will have the option to choose how they work, either scoring each section and requirement in turn or working through each supplier in turn, with improved user-friendly side navigation panel.

Requirement: Where do you intend to source the primary construction materials for this project, including structural steel, concrete aggregates, and cladding systems, and can you demonstrate that these suppliers operate within a 200-mile radius of the project site in order to minimise transportation-related carbon emissions and contribute to regional economic development?

Response: All primary construction materials proposed for this project will be sourced from established regional suppliers with proven track records in major healthcare construction programmes. Structural steel will be procured through Midco Solutions Ltd, whose rolling and fabrication facility is located in Wolverhampton approximately 118 miles from the project site, while concrete aggregates supplied by Pennine Aggregates Group from their quarrying operations is situated 74 miles from site. Cladding and external envelope systems will be manufactured by Northbird Facades, based in Warrington, 143 miles from site. All three suppliers fall comfortably within the specified 200-mile limit and each holds current ISO 14001 environmental management certification that this supply chain configuration will materially reduce transport emissions compared to national or international alternatives, and we will provide further supplier documentation upon request. In terms of material provenance and supply chain compliance, we will submit Material Provenance Declaration as part of our Stage 2 submission, cover point-of-manufacture locations, chain of custody documentation, and certifications including BE9 6001 Responsible Sourcing for structural products. Our strategy has been developed in direct response to the project's sustainability objectives, with particular regard to reducing Scope 3 carbon emissions with material logistics. We have engaged an independent supply chain audit firm to verify all declared or signed prior submission, ensuring full transparency and auditability throughout the process. This approach reflects our broader commitment to delivering the facility in a manner that is environmentally responsible, locally embedded and compliant with all relevant regulatory and contractual requirements.



As evaluators work through the scoring each supplier or requirement, progress is visually displayed both with a global project progress bar and individual markers in the side navigation panel.

Scores and rationales are filled out as the Evaluator progresses with in-page editing to make amendments and updates easier.


